Mrs. Lamb (Hoppers Class)

We have lots of fun things happening in February. We will talk more about feelings and our hearts. Of course with February comes Valentine's Day! We will be making valentines, bracelets, puppies and kittens and "delivering mail". We will talk about loving our families, our friends, and God. Please send in with your child a picture of your family to share. Sharing is a great way to have your child feel more comfortable talking in front of others. This is hard for adults too!

We have started a series of experiments. We learned that experiments are tests and a hypothesis is a guess as to what we think will happen. We tested ice last month to see which melted faster, water on ice, salt on ice or ice alone. See if your child remembers. (The salt was the fastest!) This month we'll do an experiment to help us understand why we brush our teeth! The kids get very excited about being scientists and seeing the results!

February is also dental awareness month. We will learn about our teeth, how to properly care for them and why it is so important.

In worship we will finish the Ten Commandments and start learning about the Fruit of the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-23 says, "But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, humility and self control." If we have these attributes, we are living in accord with the Holy Spirit. We will learn a fun song to help us learn these!

Students write on a clipboard 3 word in our classroom that they can read. We are learning some Nursery Rhymes, rules for sorting objects by color, shape and size, and patterning. We love being read to and especially enjoy the Pigeon book series by Mo Willems. We are excited about snow and how our world changes and looks during wintertime. It is such an exciting time of the year!

During the month of February we will focus on letters "P", "Q", "R" and "S", Valentine's Day, Presidents Day and dental health. We continue with assessments and preparing for kindergarten.
