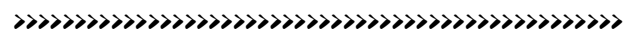

Mrs. Lamb Class: Hoppers

In November we will learn about and celebrate Thanksgiving, talk about being thankful and why it is important to thank God for our blessings. We are so blessed to have a school where we can learn about God and how God wants us to love each other. It is also important to use the words "please" and "thank you" and we reinforce those manners everyday at school. We are learning a new prayer. Ask your child to sing the prayer "We Give Thanks." The children will show how thankful they are for you by inviting you to our **Thanksgiving "mini" Feast**. The children will help prepare food, sing songs for you and then join you for feast and fellowship. The Feasts will be on **Monday, November 20 (M/W class) and Tuesday, November 21** during the last hour of class. Children are dropped off at the regular class time (with donations) and we will meet you in Noecker Hall at 10:30 am or 2:00 pm. Donation sign-up sheets will be on the "Information Station" door or you can call or e-mail if you would like to donate. We couldn't have these events without your help.

We will begin our alphabet letter matching homework. We will complete the capital letter in class and the lower case will be sent home to return finished the next class. We ask them to circle or stamp the matching letter and we practice writing our name on every paper. (Use the back if needed)

Every child will get a chance to take the *All About Me* book home. Please return it the next class day. Also, Hopper the Frog will start circulating.
